1. Announcements and New Research

A brief description limited to 100 words, and, where required, a URL link or email address of the contact person for those interested in learning more.

2. New Publications

Book: Image and title of the book; author(s); publisher and year of publication; URL link to the publisher's page featuring the book, where available.

Edited volume: Title of chapter; author(s); title of the book; editors(s); publisher and year of publication; URL link to the publisher's page featuring the book, where available.

Journals (including special issues): Name of journal and title of special issue (if any); guest editor(s) (if any); volume and issue numbers, and date of publication; URL link to table of contents of the journals, where available.

Journal articles: Title of article; author(s); name of journal; volume and issue numbers, and date of publication; URL link to the article, where available.

Working papers, occasional papers, reports, etc: Title of publication; author(s); name of publishing institution and year of publication; and URL link to the publication, where available.

In cases when the **URL is unavailable**, i.e., the publication is only available in print and has no web link, you may submit the following as images/pdf and we will create an internal Google Drive link to the item for inclusion in the SSB Newsletter.

Book/Journal: Cover page and table of contents of the book/journal.

Book chapter/Journal article: Cover page and table of contents of the book/journal; the first page of the chapter/article as published.
