His doctoral research titled 'Ethnic Uprising in Nepal's Tarai: The Making of Madhesi Identity in the Post-civil War Transition' studies ethnopolitical groups and political realignment in the post-war context, exploring how Madhesi identity evolved after the 2006 Comprehensive Peace Accord. It also looks at diverse contextual issues, including state policies and practices, the changing Madhesi political context, and the impact of the Maoist insurgency on the process of Madhesi identity development. Edited volume: Title of chapter; author(s); title of the book; editors(s); publisher and year of publication; URL link to the publisher's page featuring the book, where available.

Journals (including special issues): Name of journal and title of special issue (if any); guest editor(s) (if any); volume and issue numbers, and date of publication; URL link to table of contents of the journals, where available.

Title of article; author(s); name of journal; volume and issue numbers, and date Journal articles: of publication; URL link to the article, where available.

Working papers, occasional papers, reports, etc: Title of publication; author(s); name of publishing institution and year of publication; and URL link to the publication, where available.

In cases when the URL is unavailable, i.e., the publication is only available in print and has no web link, you may submit the following as images/pdf and we will create an internal Google Drive link to the item for inclusion in the SSB Newsletter.

Book/Journal: Cover page and table of contents of the book/journal.

Book chapter/Journal article: Cover page and table of contents of the book/journal; the first page of the chapter/article as published.
