NEW RESEARCH

Josef Neubauer, PhD candidate at the University for Continuing Education Krems, is currently leading a collaborative research project between the University for Continuing Education Krems (Austria) and Centre for the Study of Labour and Mobility (CESLAM), Social Science Baha, titled 'Dynamics of Adaptive Migration Aspirations in Nepal and Beyond (DYNAMIGS–DIAMOND, 2023–2027)'. The project seeks to understand how young people's wishes and goals to migrate and stay change over time. It studies these processes among young Nepalis living in Kathmandu Valley and Gorkha District (Nepal), Lisbon (Portugal), and Vienna (Austria). It also aims to learn how people's changing migration aspirations affect their wellbeing. Methodologically, the project combines a two-wave online survey with interviews and participant observation.
